

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

Project Overview - Project Location




Project Overview - Significant Adjacent Projects

Project History

2003 East Corridor MIS

- I-30 From west of I-45 to Dalrock Rd.
- Multimodal recommendations including bike/ped, transit, and I-30 capacity improvements

2005 Project Pegasus


- Included I-30 from Beckley Ave. to east of I-45 and I-35E from Colorado Blvd. to SH 183
- Approved schematic and environmental assessment
- Constructed I-30/I-35E Horseshoe Project

2016 CityMAP

- I-30 scenarios considered:
 - Canyon compressed
 - I-30 East Dallas below grade
 - Relocate I-30 to south









I-30 Canyon Concept






Existing I-30 Typical Section (Looking East near St. Paul St.)




Proposed I-30 Typical Section (Looking East near St. Paul St.)

Surplus Right of Way (ROW) Process

- Process begins once construction is complete, and is handled by TxDOT ROW Division, Real Estate Services
- Property owner submits disposition of surplus request to TxDOT ROW Division, Real Estate Services
- Survey and appraisal of the surplus property are provided by the property owner
- All offers are for appraised value only (not negotiable)
- 1st Priority: three local government agencies have 30 days to accept offer
 - City of Dallas
- -- Dallas County
- -- Dallas ISD
- 2nd Priority: all abutting property owners have 30 days to accept offer
- 3rd Priority: offered to public for highest bidder above appraised value
 - Advertised daily in newspaper for two weeks
 - Offerors may submit sealed bids
 - Date/place specified for bid opening
 - Sold to highest bidder

Next Steps: I-45/I-345 Interchange Improvements

- Feasibility Study for I-345 under way by TxDOT
- Studies I-345 from I-30 to Spur 366 Woodall Rodgers Freeway
- Allowance in I-30 Canyon design for I-345 interchange improvements
- I-30 Canyon design will not preclude any options for I-345

Guiding Principles for I-30 Redesign

- Based on Foundational Studies, City's response to TxDOT should support guiding principles for redesign that will:
 - 1. Accommodate multi-modal connections across the I-30 corridor
 - Incorporate "complete streets" and other urban design elements to frontage roads
 - 3. New I-30 should not be any higher or any wider than the current I-30
 - Include "at-grade" crossings to improve neighborhood connectivity
 - Include better multi-modal connection to the High Speed Rail station area
 - 5. Maintain the street grid, where appropriate
 - 6. Maximize development potential of abandoned right-of-way through ramp re-configuration
 - 7. Provide for strategic placement of deck parks
 - 8. Allow for alternative scenarios for I-345 redesign
 - Prefer that project include design and plans for construction of I-345 concurrent with I-30 project



I-30 Canyon Public Meeting

City of Dallas Partnership (by City of Dallas)

- Providing for complete streets on I-30 bridge crossings and city streets
- Coordinating with adjacent property owners on access and city street grid
- Coordinating with TxDOT on locating viable deck plazas/parks
- Coordinating with TxDOT on allowances for surplus Right of Way (ROW)

NEXT STEPS:

- Public comment period ends (November 13, 2019)
- Anticipated environmental clearance (2020)
- Plan preparation
- Approval of construction plans

Funded by State's 2020 Unified Transportation Plan – August 2019

Develop Schematic & Environmental Studies - Fall 2019 to Spring 2020

Finalize Schematic/ Prepare Environmental Document - Summer 2020

Complete Environmental Documentation - 2020

Construction Plan Prep and ROW Acquisition - 2020 to 2021

Construction - Date To Be Determined (~3 Years to Build)
