

Project Purpose and Need



Purpose:


The purpose of the proposed project is to improve mobility in the corridor by adding capacity to alleviate congestion, improve operations to reduce existing bottlenecks, enhance mobility options by including bicycle and pedestrian accommodations, and to enhance safety of the corridor by upgrading the facility to meet current design standards.

Need:

The proposed project is needed because the roadway capacity is inadequate to meet existing and future traffic demand, is not up to current design standards, and because there is lack of continuous accommodations for bicycles and pedestrians.

Existing Typical Section





*Mainlanes Note:

<u>Ferguson Road to US 80:</u> 8 Existing Mainlanes (4 each direction) including contraflow HOV system during peak hours

<u>US 80 to I-635:</u> 6 Existing Mainlanes (3 each direction) including contraflow HOV system during peak hours (HOV lane temporarily closed due to I-635 construction)

<u>I-635 to Bass Pro Drive:</u> 6-8 Existing Mainlanes (3 - 4 each direction)


Proposed Typical Sections – I-30 from Ferguson Road to US 80






Proposed Typical Sections – I-30 from US 80 to I-635

- All right of way acquisition would be completed in accordance with the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisitions Policies Act of 1970, as amended.
