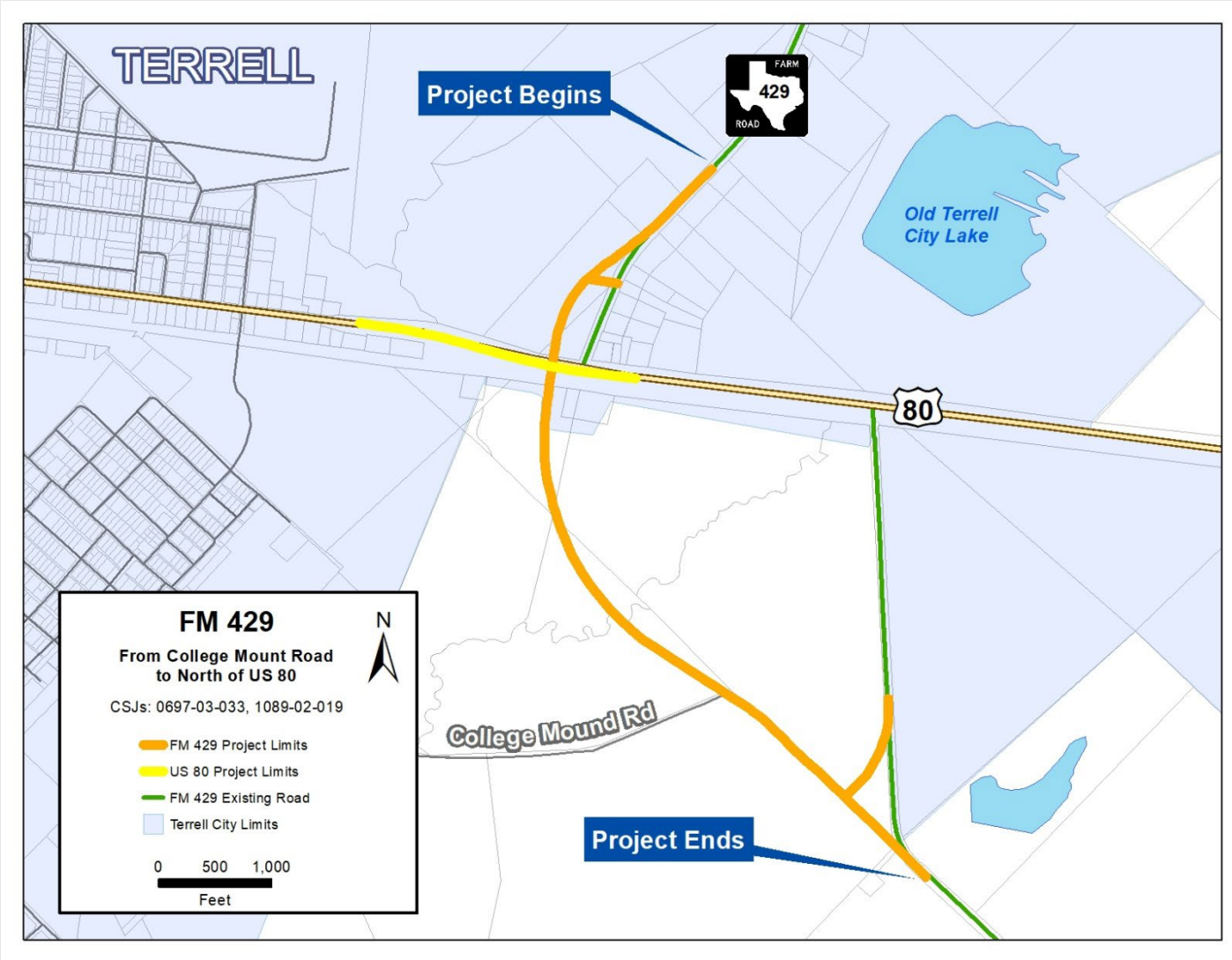

PROJECT LIMITS: From 0.44 mile north of US 80 to College Mound Road

PROJECT LENGTH: Approximately 1.6 miles





The proposed project would:

- Realign and construct FM 429 as a two-lane (ultimate four-lane) rural minor arterial roadway with flush medians and shoulders.
- Improve the intersection at US 80 and FM 429 and reconstruct the Union Pacific Railroad crossing south of the intersection.



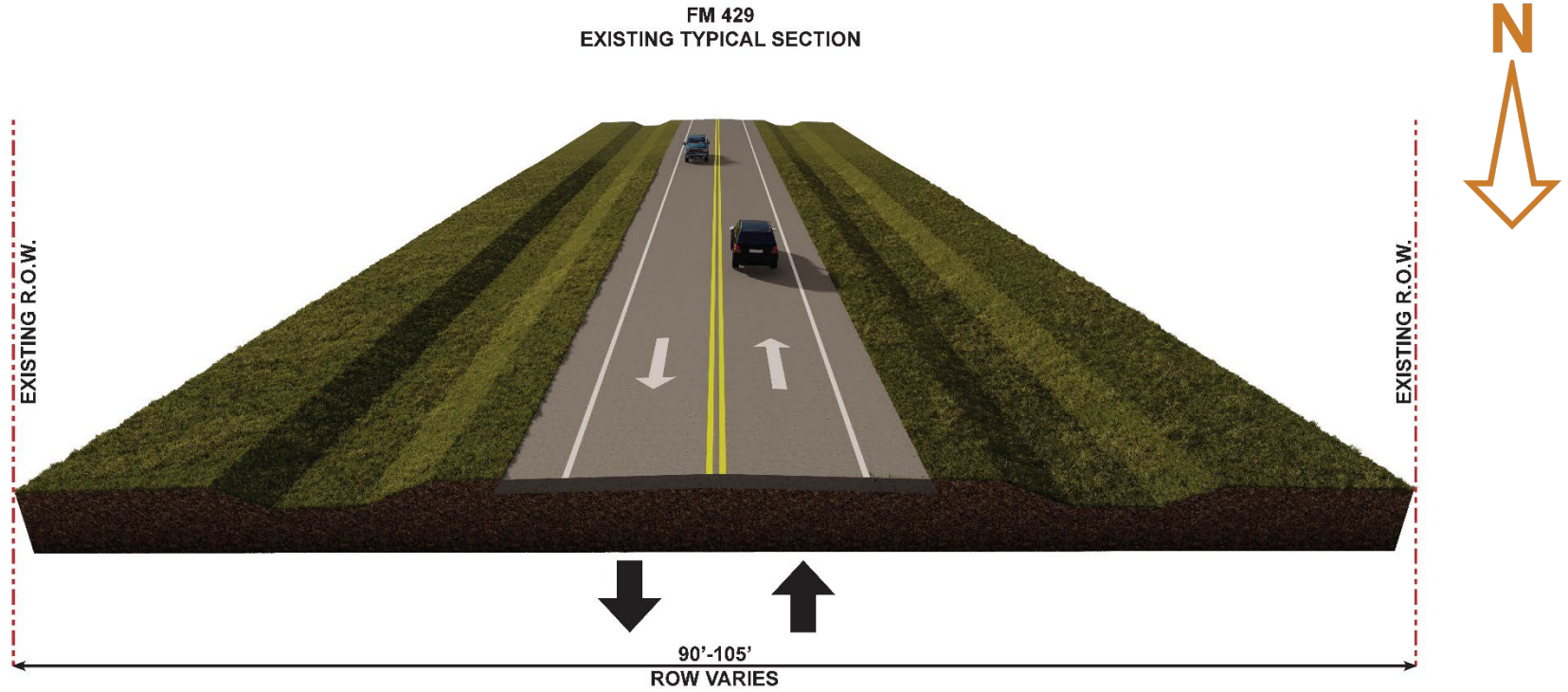
Project Purpose:

The purpose of the proposed project is to re-align and improve the intersection of FM 429 and US 80 in order to improve north-south and east-west mobility, safety and to accommodate future traffic demand by adding capacity.

Project Need:

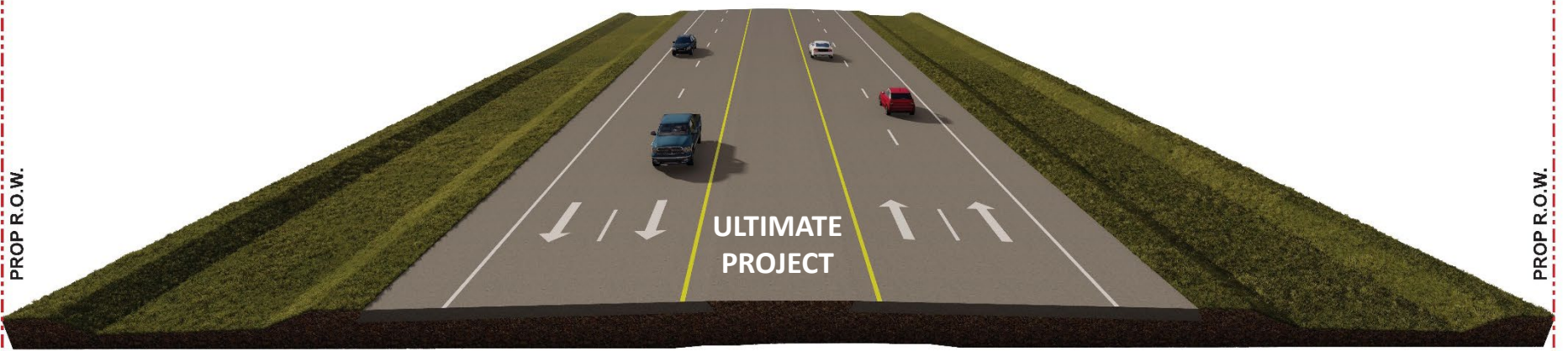
The proposed project is needed to correct the FM 429 off-set intersection at US 80 and improve the operation of the Union Pacific Railroad crossing.

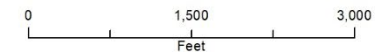

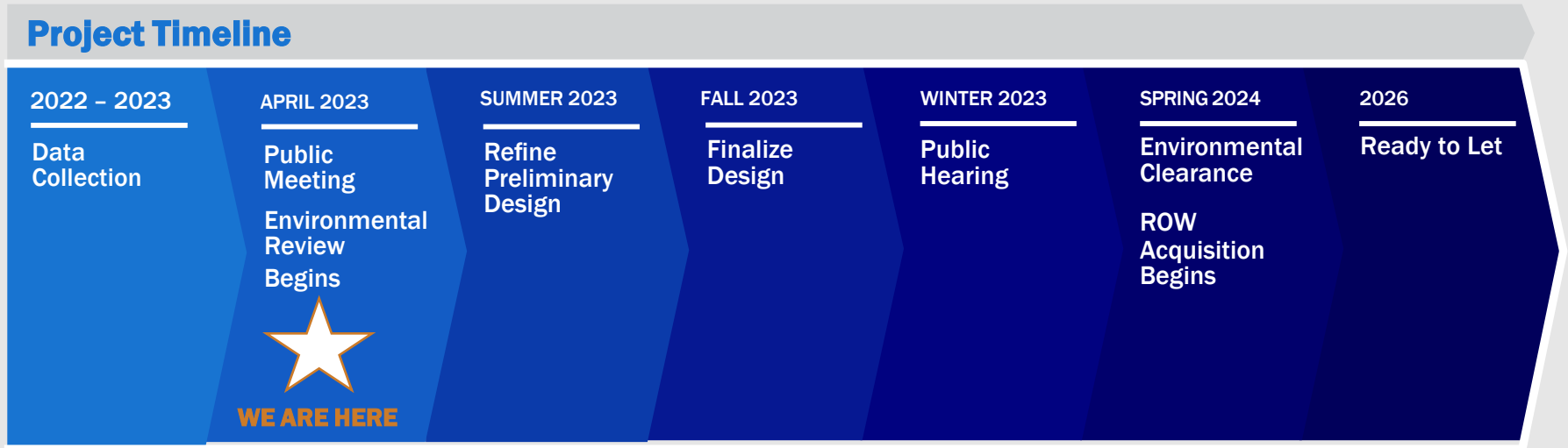


Proposed Right-of-Way (ROW)

- No potential commercial and/or residential displacements
- All ROW acquisition would be completed in accordance with the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, as amended.
