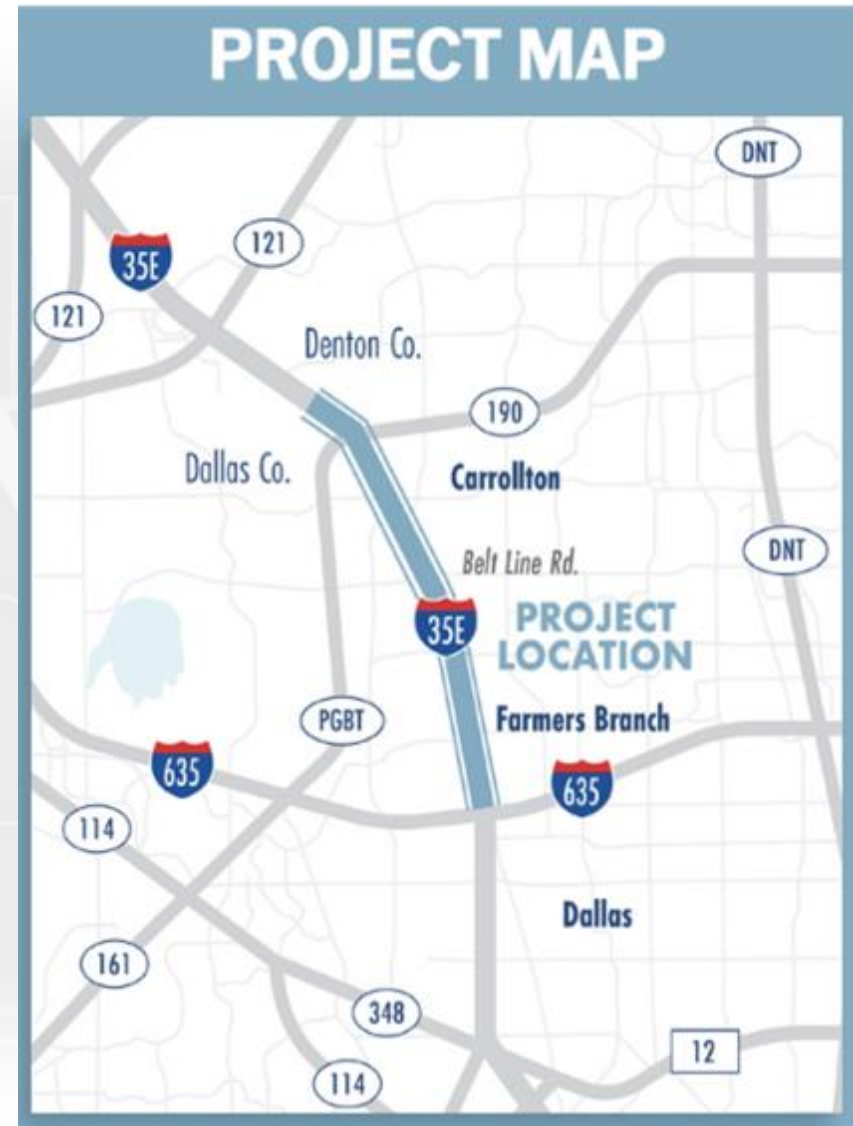
The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is responsible for maintaining approximately 80,000 miles of road and for supporting aviation, maritime, rail and public transportation across the state. TxDOT's mission is "Connecting You with Texas."



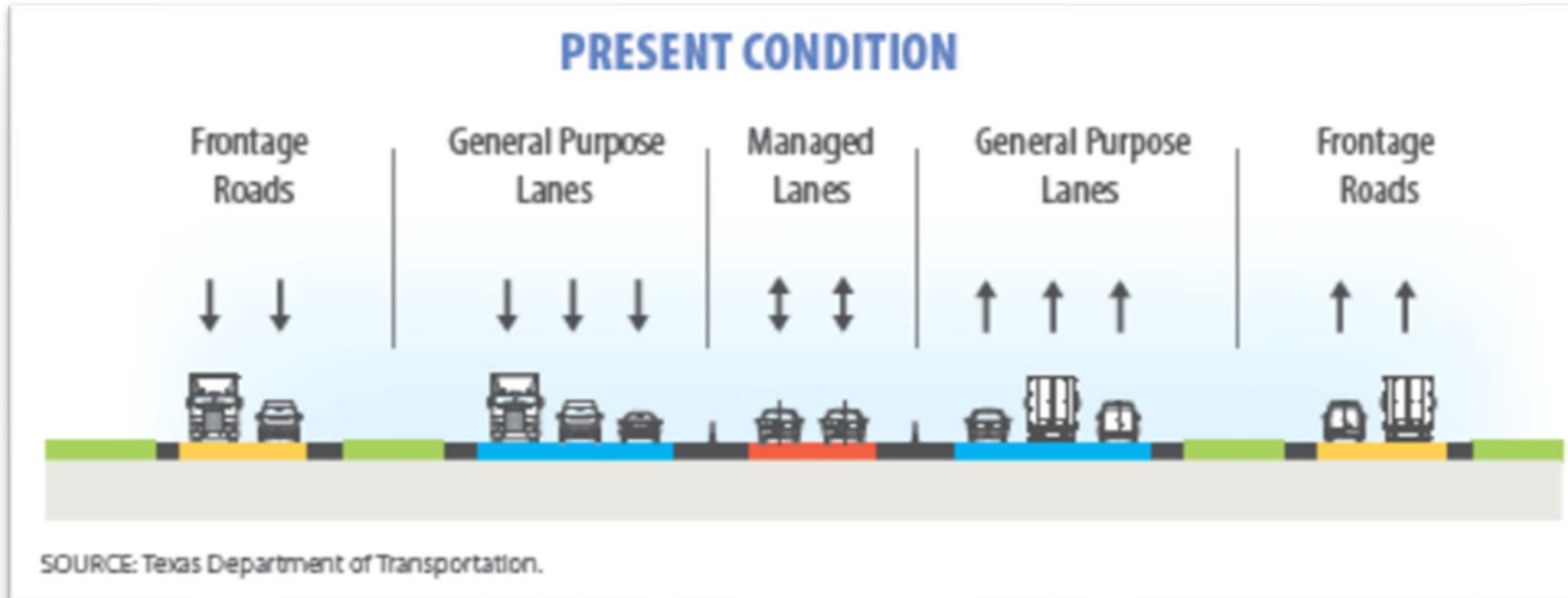
Lone Star Constructors (LSC) is a joint venture of Fluor Heavy Civil, LLC (Fluor) and Austin Bridge & Road, LP (Austin). With 19 years of design-build experience in Texas, Fluor has led the delivery of successful design-build projects for TxDOT, including the Dallas District.

Project Limits

- ▶ 6.39 miles
- ▶ Dallas/Denton County
- ▶ Begins just north of 635 and will continue north of PGBT/190
- ▶ Impacted cities include Dallas, Carrollton and Farmers Branch
- ▶ Full reconstruction of the existing 6 general purpose lanes to 8 general purpose lanes, with auxiliary lanes at entrance and exit ramps including frontage roads
- ▶ Toll Managed Lanes will remain 2 reversible lanes
- ▶ Construction timeline: 2022-2025



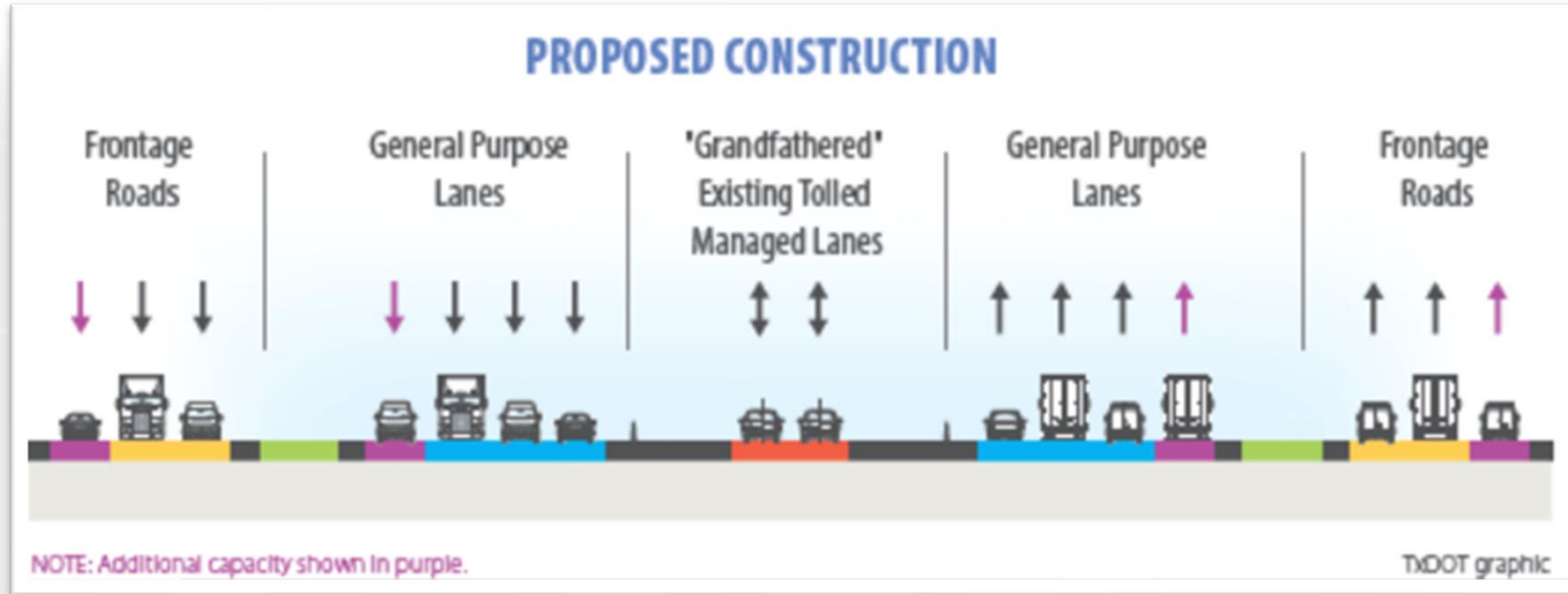
Existing Lanes



The existing I-35E has:

- ▶ Three general purpose lanes in each direction
- ▶ One HOV/Managed Lane in each direction, separated by delineators from the general-purpose lanes

Proposed Lanes



When construction is complete, I-35E will have:

- ▶ One additional general-purpose lane in each direction in Dallas County
- ▶ Two managed toll lanes with shoulders, separated from the general-purpose lanes by concrete barriers
- ▶ Widened frontage roads



Full reconstruction of the I-35E mainlines, two existing, reversible tolled managed lanes, and frontage roads in Dallas County.

The I-35E Phase 2 project will reconstruct and widen a 6.39-mile southern section of I-35E in Dallas County from I-635 to Denton County Line. The project will consist of widening the section from 6 to 8 lanes and improving intersections and frontage roads to decrease congestion and improve safety for motorists. This project has been identified through the Texas Clear Lanes Initiative, a statewide strategic plan, as an area in need of updates in order to relieve traffic congestion and increase economic development.
