


# **Project Limits**

35E Phase 2


- ▶ 6.39 miles
- Dallas/Denton County
- Begins just north of 635 and will continue north of PGBT/190
- Impacted cities include Dallas, Carrollton and Farmers Branch
- Full reconstruction of the existing 6 general purpose lanes to 8 general purpose lanes, with auxiliary lanes at entrance and exit ramps including frontage roads
- ▶ Toll Managed Lanes will remain 2 reversible lanes
- Construction timeline: 2022-2025





# **Existing Lanes**






### The existing I-35E has:

# Proposed Lanes






### When construction is complete, I-35E will have:

- Widened frontage roads









