



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**  
**Proposed Improvements to Farm-to-Market Road (FM) 407**  
**From West of FM 156 to FM 1830**  
**Denton County, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is conducting a Feasibility Study for improvements to Farm-to-Market Road (FM) 407 through Denton County. The limits of the study are from West of FM 156 to FM 1830, a distance of approximately 13 miles. TxDOT will conduct a public meeting to discuss and receive public comments on the proposed study. The meeting will be held on **Thursday, March 21, 2019** at the **Justin Elementary School, 425 Boss Range Road, Justin, Texas 76247**. This meeting will be held in an open house format from **6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.** Representatives from TxDOT and project consultants will be available to answer questions about the proposed project improvements.

The purpose of the study is to analyze potential roadway options to improve FM 407, including improving the existing alignment or utilizing new alignments. Alignment options could require additional right-of-way to accommodate the project.

Maps showing FM 407 roadway alignment concepts will be available for viewing at the public meeting. This information will also be on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at the TxDOT Dallas District Office, 4777 E. Highway 80, Mesquite, TX 75150 and the TxDOT Denton County Area Office located at 2624 W. Prairie, Denton, TX 76201. Project information will also be available online at [www.keepitmovingdallas.com](http://www.keepitmovingdallas.com) under Upcoming Public Hearing/Meeting.

All interested persons are invited to attend the public meeting. Written comments from the public are requested and will be accepted for a period of 15 calendar days following the meeting.
