
Project Purpose:

Improve safety, increase mobility and meet current design standards.

Project Need:

The proposed project is needed to meet future travel demands stemming from projected population growth and traffic volumes.

Existing Typical Section



- Consists of two 12-foot-wide travel lanes in each direction with 4-foot inside shoulders and 10-foot outside shoulders
- 66-foot grassy median
- Existing right of way is 250-feet-wide
- No existing sidewalk, bicycle or pedestrian facilities


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Proposed Typical Section



Project improvements would include:

- Construction of new of two 12-foot-wide frontage roads in each direction with variable left-hand turn lanes both northbound and southbound
- Addition of a 10-foot shared-use path on the northbound side and a 6-foot sidewalk on the southbound side of US 287
- Interchange improvements at US 287 from Boyce Road and Cooke Road
- Proposed right of way ranges from 297 to 324-feet with a 40-foot median

*Project is currently unfunded for construction and cannot let until funding is identified; however, right of way acquisition can proceed even if the project is not funded for construction.


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Constraints Map

 - Right of Way/Easements
 - Traffic Noise
 - Vegetation and Wildlife
 - Water Resources

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
Right of Way



- Proposed Right of Way & Displacements
 - The proposed project would require the acquisition of approximately 23 acres of right of way
 - The proposed project would displace one non-residential structure
 - Right-of-Way acquisition will be in accordance with the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970
