Purpose:

The purpose of the public meeting is to solicit comments on proposed improvements to Farm-to Market Road (FM) 1641 from FM 548 to FM 148 and to FM 548 from FM 1641 to U.S. Highway (US) 80. The meeting will be held in an open house format. Maps will be available for viewing at the public meeting. Representatives from TxDOT and project consultants will be available to answer questions. Comments must be received on or before Friday, July 26, 2019, to be a part of the official record.

Description:

The FM 1641 reconstruction project includes widening approximately 0.2 miles of FM 548 and approximately 5.4 miles of FM 1641. The existing FM 548 is a 4-lane urban roadway, and the existing FM 1641 is a rural 2-lane roadway. Both roadways would be reconstructed to an urban 4-lane (ultimate 6-lane) section with turn lanes. 

Abbott signs property tax relief bill

City, county leaders say law's cap will restrict public safety spending

AUSTIN — Gov. Greg Abbott triumphantly delivered his top campaign promise to voters Wednesday when he signed into law a bill — detested by city and county leaders — that caps how much local government can collect in property taxes.

Abbott was flanked by Lt. Gov. Dan Patrick and House Speaker Dennis Bonnen, as well as several lawmakers from the House and Senate, as he said the law creates “substantial property tax relief” and “lasting, meaningful, tangible results” for homeowners and

businesses.

Abbott said the law works in tandem with a landmark school finance bill he signed Tuesday that provides \$5 billion in state funds to schools to help buy down local school property taxes. That bill, Abbott said, would lower property taxes by an average of 5% the first year and 10% the second year. Some have raised questions about the bill's long-term viability because the Legislature must come back in 2021 to fund further years.

“Our goal in passing SB 2 is to ensure that the benefits of the property tax buydown that I signed yesterday will be felt by businesses like this and by homeowners across the state of Texas for years to come,” he said as he signed the law at Wally's Burger Express, a family-owned restaurant in Austin.

Senate Bill 2 is expected to slow how fast property tax bills grow for home and business owners, who have seen them rise as much as 6% to 10% a year. Notably, the new law doesn't shrink bills, but aims to ensure that the state-provided relief in the school finance bill is not quickly erased by the rise of city and county taxes.

Under the new law, cities and counties can collect only 3.5% more in property tax revenue than they did the previous year without calling an election to get voter approval. Under the school bill, school districts can collect only 2.5% more and don't have the option to call an election for a higher rate.

Previously, cities and counties could collect up to 8% more in property tax revenue a year, without the threat of an election — a threshold the city

of Dallas routinely bumped up against, resulting in higher property taxes for residents.

Dallas opposition

City and county leaders vigorously opposed the bill, saying it would stifle their budgets and prevent them from adequately funding public safety. Property taxes are typically the top source of revenue for local government budgets, with public safety making up more than half.

Outgoing Dallas Mayor Mike Rawlings has said the bill would result in cuts to services and could prevent the city from hiring 100 new police officers.

“The City of Dallas is the delivery entity for the daily services residents expect: everything from public safety to storm cleanup to street maintenance

to clean water. The state's imposition of revenue caps ... inhibits our ability to deliver the services our residents ask for such as increasing pay and hiring sworn officers,” said Dallas City Council member Lee Kleinman, who lobbied the Legislature against the proposal.

At the signing ceremony, state lawmakers downplayed those concerns, with Bonnen calling it a “false narrative.” He said the 3.5% cap is a good point to have a conversation with taxpayers about the need for more money.

Will initiatives last?

Questions remain about the viability of the tax proposals. The state has provided enough money to reduce public school property taxes for the next two

years, but no funding source to maintain it.

Abbott, Bonnen and Patrick floated a plan during the session that would buy down property taxes by increasing the sales tax by a penny. The idea failed to gain traction from state lawmakers, who feared being tagged as supporting a tax increase.

Abbott said if voters want more property tax reductions and can stomach the idea of moving toward sales taxes, “the issue will come back again.” But he said he wants to listen to voters and see how this session's funding mechanisms for tax relief play out before reconsidering the idea.

A Greystar spokeswoman said Wednesday it was still too early to determine whether the Elan City Lights building would be torn down. The company has not said whether it plans to compensate residents for items that were destroyed.

Back in business

Leo Morales, general manager of the Smoky Rose restaurant near White Rock Lake, was about to pick up gas for a generator when three men in Alabama Power hats pulled up in a pickup behind the business.

One of them used a long yellow stick to manipulate equipment on top of a utility pole, and soon the power lines at the corner of Garland Road and Lakeland Drive buzzed for a moment. Seconds later, the restaurant's air conditioner kicked in.

Morales said he was relieved, most of all for the restaurant's other employees.

“I was more concerned about our staff because in the service industry you depend on tips, and they didn't get tips Sunday, they didn't get tips Monday, they didn't get tips Tuesday or today — and most of them live day-to-day, paycheck-to-paycheck.” Eleven utility trucks with license plates from Louisiana and Kentucky idled Wednesday afternoon in a strip mall parking lot on Mockingbird Lane, near Abrams Road, in northeast Dallas. Sixteen more from Mississippi and Kentucky were stationed a few miles away outside a Sam's Club.

Victims from collapse

Sunday's collapse at the Elan City Lights building killed 29-year-old Kiersten Symone Smith and injured five other people.

Smith's family said in a statement Wednesday that she had recently gotten engaged to Eric Ridenhour. The two were planning to get married in September.

“Instead of planning a wedding, our family is mourning her loss and struggling to make sense out of this tragedy,” the family said in a written statement. “Kiersten's death is unbelievable, shocking and unnecessary.”

Another victim, 40-year-old Jay Bosquez, was still in the intensive care unit with a broken neck, said Ragan Speer, one of Bosquez's attorneys.

Sunday's catastrophe

The crane that fell from the Gabriella construction site onto the Elan City Lights apartments killed one resident and injured others.




IN THE KNOW Getting food aid after the storm

If you qualify for food provided by the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program and your food was destroyed during a power outage, you likely qualify for replacement benefits.

Kelli Weldon, a spokeswoman for Texas Health and Human Services, said via email that SNAP recipients who experience a household disaster that results in destroyed food that was purchased with their benefits are eligible but must act quickly.

The household needs to request replacement benefits by visiting their local Health and Human Services office within 10 days of their food being

destroyed. There they will have to sign an Affidavit for Nonreceipt of Destroyed Food Stamp Benefits form, also known as HI855.

The North Texas Food Bank is accepting non-perishable food donations and monetary donations to help with efforts to assist others who can't afford to replace their destroyed food, and Pat Patey, a spokesman for the Salvation Army, said Wednesday that their food pantry — located next to Parkland Memorial Hospital on Harry Hines Boulevard — is open to anyone who may need groceries.

There's too much swelling for Bosquez to undergo surgery, so medical staff are just trying to manage his pain, Speer said.

Bosquez lived at Elan City Lights with his wife and 8-year-old son, Speer said. But he was the only one home when the crane came crashing through his fifth-floor apartment.

He was able to save his puppy, Joey, and rescuers eventually recovered the family's kitten, Bing, but “they've lost everything,” Speer said.

Speer said Bosquez and his wife, Yesenia, were grateful to police and fire crews, whose work was “exceptional” in the wake of the collapse.

The attorney said the Bosquez family was waiting to determine whether they would file a lawsuit until after the cause of the collapse was determined.

“We are waiting to get the clearance from OSHA, and then we will go in and peel the onion back and find out what was the actual cause of it and who the liable parties are,” she said.

Cleaning up debris

Utility crews cleaning up from the storms have had to work around and among countless fallen branches and

uprooted trees.

Oncor spokeswoman Jen Myers said Sunday's “monstrous storm” damaged 3% to 4% of the vegetation in the city.

The city has been responding to thousands of calls to collect debris.

The sanitation services department has been working to clear residential areas the same way it normally collects brush and bulk waste, city spokesman Corbin Rubinson said. But to speed up the process, more than 20 contract crews have been brought in to help.

At properties the city's Park and Recreation Department oversees, some debris is being turned into mulch or compost. Debris that remains in streets is being cleared by the city's public works teams so sanitation crews can collect it.

Residents with downed trees can call 311 for assistance, and people who want to haul their own debris may take it to the McCommas Bluff Landfill or transfer stations. More information is available at dallaszerowaste.com.

City officials have said code compliance workers will not issue trash citations for storm debris that has been set out before normal collection times.

DISD apologizes to valedictorian

Speech was silenced when grad spoke of ‘victims of injustice’

Dallas ISD has issued an apology to the Conrad High School valedictorian whose microphone was cut off when she named black shooting victims at the school's graduation ceremony two weeks ago.

“It is never our intent to censor anyone's freedom of speech,” the district said Monday in a written statement. “Students have that right — Dallas ISD encourages it.”

Rooha Haghar's speech gained national attention after she posted a video in which her microphone was silenced after she dedicated a line of her speech “to Trayvon Martin and Tamir Rice and all the other children who became victims of injustice.”

The district said it is a practice for all valedictorian and salutatorian speeches to be reviewed. So when Haghar went off-script, the principal made the decision to limit Haghar's remarks. But the district acknowledged that it is charged with ensuring the rights of all students.

“In hindsight, we realize this decision may not have been reflective of the core values we teach our students, as we work to educate

leaders of tomorrow. For that, we apologize,” the district said in the statement.

Haghar said on Twitter that her principal had cut out that line from her speech because he was concerned that it sent the wrong message to graduates. But Haghar, an Iranian immigrant, said she was shocked to be silenced for delivering the unedited speech.

Haghar finally delivered her full speech over the weekend after Sybrina Fulton, the mother of Trayvon Martin, gave her a platform on the Trayvon Martin Foundation website and on Instagram.

In the speech, Haghar asks graduates to remember those who were “robbed” of the opportunity to pursue an education.

Trayvon was fatally shot by George Zimmerman, a neighborhood watch volunteer, near his home in Florida in 2012. Zimmerman was charged with the murder of the 17-year-old but was later acquitted.

Tamir was fatally shot by Cleveland police Officer Timothy Loehman in 2014. Loehman was not charged in the 12-year-old's death and was recently hired by another department in Ohio, according to *The Hill*.

Haghar plans to attend the University of Texas at Austin in the fall, according to KXAS-TV (NBC5).





Por la crisis, venezolanos reciclan más

Ingenio y creatividad es ayudan a solventar problemas económicos

Caracas - En Venezuela, las esperanzas financieras de Eliset González están puestas en un nicho de mercado.

A diario, González se sienta en un puesto en un mercado de Caracas y repara bombillas rotas para aquellos que no pueden permitirse una nueva en una nación devastada por la crisis.

“Siento que con esto ayudo a la comunidad ya que esos bombillos están súper caros. Además, me ayudo yo también”, dijo González.

Según sus cálculos, una bombilla fluorescente compacta nueva puede costar el equivalente a varios dólares en la devaluada moneda

venezolana, o el equivalente a casi el salario de un mes. Pese a esto, la calidad es tan mala que puede durar apenas una semana.

Con una reparación, pueden funcionar durante más de seis meses más y por una parte de ese precio, explicó González.

Su extraño trabajo es una respuesta ingeniosa al caos económico que domina la que en su día fue una rica nación petrolera, donde la escasez de comida y medicamentos ha llevado a más de cuatro millones de venezolanos a buscar refugio en todo el mundo en los últimos años. El año pasado, la creciente hiperinflación alcanzó el millón por ciento.

Pero en este escenario de decadencia económica, la historia de González no es original.

En otra parte de la ciudad, Vladimir Fajardo reúne algo de dinero reciclando objetos aleatorios.

Muchos días se sienta en una acera de Caracas y utiliza una cuchara afilada para cons-

truir autos de juguete con botellas de plástico, a los que les instala un sistema interno de poleas con bandas de goma para hacer que las partes del coche giren. Cada juguete le toma alrededor de media hora.

“Hay gente que me dice ‘¿y si te doy un dólar? ¿Un dólar te sirve?’”, dijo Fajardo. “Sí, deme un dólar. Después lo vendo y con eso como”.

Fajardo, que en el pasado tuvo problemas de drogadicción y recorre los vecindarios de la capital venezolana en busca de clientes, está orgulloso de su trabajo.

Para Elizabeth Cordido, una psicóloga social en la Universidad Metropolitana de Caracas, los intentos de los venezolanos por sobrevivir reciclando artículos que de otra forma irían a la basura es, de algún modo, positivo.

“Es muy negativo que sea a través de la pobreza y del incremento de la pobreza que hayamos llegado a esto”, dijo. “Es doloroso”.

México homenajea a víctimas de la ‘guerra sucia’ de los 70

Ciudad de México — El primero de una serie de monumentos en honor de las víctimas de la llamada “guerra sucia” en México contra disidentes y guerrilleros durante casi 20 años fue inaugurado el lunes.

Las autoridades develaron el monumento en la sede de la desaparecida Dirección Federal de Seguridad, donde en 1971 fueron trasladados estudiantes tras la represión a una protesta, hecho que se conoce como la Masacre del Jueves de Corpus o “El Halconazo”. El monumento incluirá documentos desclasificados y otros materiales de los archivos nacionales.

En la ceremonia de inauguración, Alejandro Encinas, subsecretario de Derechos Humanos, Migración y Población, de la Secretaría de Gobernación, explicó que el objetivo es recuperar la memoria y documentar las graves violaciones a los derechos humanos en el conflicto que se extendió durante toda la década de 1970.

Durante la “guerra sucia” de México, cientos de personas vinculadas con la izquierda fueron detenidas ilegalmente, torturadas y

desaparecidas a manos de las fuerzas de seguridad.

Dos víctimas hablaron de la importancia de recuperar lo ocurrido en estos lugares. Una de ellas es Martha Alicia Camacho, una exprofesora que fue torturada junto con su esposo en 1977. A la larga él fue ejecutado.

“Obviamente no nos entregaron su cuerpo, ni nada”, afirmó. “Yo fui obligada a parir en medio de golpes un hijo, 50 días después de estar detenida”.

“Todavía no alcanzamos la justicia”, la cual “está con los ojos cerrados o no existe”, agregó.

Alberto Híjar Serrano, otro sobreviviente de la “guerra sucia”, dijo que el hecho de que estos lugares sean transformados en monumentos debería servir como una forma de acordarse de los que fueron secuestrados, asesinados y torturados. Los desaparecidos tienen un rostro, un nombre, y es necesario que sean recordados, añadió.

Se donaron más de 100 obras fotográficas y de otro tipo para el primer monumento.

El próximo a ser inaugurado estará en los sótanos de la Secretaría de Gobernación, donde también hubo torturas y homicidios.





Did you know?





A raised median would be added, and 14-foot wide shared-use lanes to accommodate bicycles and 6-foot wide sidewalks would be added in each direction. The existing right-of-way (ROW) width is approximately 90 feet wide. The proposed project ROW width would be approximately 130 feet wide. Approximately 20.3 acres of new ROW and 3.0 acres of proposed permanent drainage easements would be required to accommodate the proposed improvements.

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I would like to state first that I totally agree that these roads need improved and widened, however, I disagree with many aspects of the proposed design as stated below:

- 1) If possible, any ROW acquisitions should occur equitably on both sides of the road (i.e. you propose to take 40' of my improved commercial land and not 1' of the pasture land across the street). Taking 40' of prime frontage off my commercial property will demolish my Ice House and cut approximately 35% off the end of my planned and approved strip center set to break ground shortly.
- 2) It doesn't matter what type of road you redesignate FM 1641 as, it will remain a main artery into and away from Forney. Traffic needs to be able to maintain, at least close to, the current posted speeds. Therefore, in my and all the residents I've conversed with opinion, it is ill advised, UNSAFE and unwanted to construct bike lanes, thus encouraging bicycles on this road that will guarantee future injuries and possible fatalities.
- 3) Six foot wide sidewalks in both directions? Really? Not a single resident I've talked to wants this! It might make sense for a short distance close to a school but on both sides of the road for approximately 5.6 miles, that's 11.2 total miles of sidewalk and is an obscene waste of taxpayer funds, not to mention 12' of ROW width.
- 4) Raised median in the center. Why? It would be much more efficient and safer to have a continuous turn lane in the center instead of a raised median, at least in areas that have, or likely will have multiple ingress and egress. If raised medians are constructed there will be unnecessary cost and inconvenience associated with the continuous demo and reconstruction of turn lanes (as evidenced now on FM 548 at FM 1641). Raised medians are also a continuous cost to maintain unless they're totally concreted on the surface, which would be unlikely. Now the norm is to install sprinkler systems, grass, plants, and trees that impede the vision of drivers.
- 5) Regardless of your final design, commercial vehicles have to be able to turn into my storage facility from either direction.

In closing, I trust the issues I've addressed will be considered. I have been an active part of this community for 25 years. I would like to request a meeting, in person, with a decision maker to discuss this further. I can be contacted at 214-957-2006.


