NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

U.S. HIGHWAY 80 (US 80)

From Interstate Highway 30 (I-30) to Farm-to-Market Road (FM) 460

CSJs: 0095-02-096, 0095-02-107, 0095-03-080, & 0095-10-033

Dallas County and Kaufman County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing improvements to US 80 from I-30 to FM 460 in Dallas and Kaufman counties, Texas. Pursuant to Texas Administrative Code, Title 43, Part 1, Chapter 2, Subchapter E, §2.105 and Code of Federal Regulations, Title 23, Chapter I, Subchapter H, §771.111 and Title 40, Chapter V, §1506, this notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a public meeting to discuss and receive public comments on the proposed project. **The meeting will be held on Tuesday, March 28, 2017, at North Mesquite High School (cafeteria), 18201 Lyndon B. Johnson Freeway, Mesquite, TX 75150.** Representatives from TxDOT and project consultants will be available to answer questions about the proposed project improvements. **The meeting will be held in an open house format from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. with no formal presentation.**

Proposed improvements to US 80 would widen this highway from I-30 in Dallas County to FM 460 in Kaufman County, approximately 11 miles. The proposed improvements include reconstructing and widening the existing four-lane roadway to a six-lane roadway. To accommodate the proposed improvements, ramps, bridge structures, and frontage roads would be reconstructed. Additional right of way is anticipated to be required along US 80.

Maps depicting the location of proposed improvements and the geometric design will be available for viewing at the public meeting. The information will also be available for public inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at the TxDOT Dallas District Office, 4777 E. Highway 80, Mesquite, TX 75150; TxDOT Kaufman Area Office, 2750 S. Washington, Kaufman, TX 75142; City of Forney City Hall, 101 E. Main Street, Forney, TX 75126; City of Mesquite City Hall, 757 N. Galloway Avenue, Mesquite, TX 75149; and the Town of Sunnyvale Town Hall, 127 N. Collins Road, Sunnyvale, TX 75182. The information will be available online at www.keepitmovingdallas.com under Upcoming Public Hearing/Meeting.

All interested persons are invited to attend the public meeting. Written comments from the public are requested and will be accepted for a period of 15 calendar days following the meeting. Written comments may be submitted either in person at the public meeting, by mail to the TxDOT Dallas District Office, Attention: Mr. Mike Renfrow, P.E., 4777 E. Highway 80, Mesquite, TX 75150-6643, or by email addressed to mike.renfrow@txdot.gov. **Written comments must be received or postmarked on or before Wednesday, April 12, 2017 to be included in the documentation of the public meeting.**

The public meeting will be conducted in English.
