NEPA requires TxDOT, as part of the EIS process, to evaluate all viable alternatives considered and eliminated during the Feasibility Study, as well as others developed by TxDOT.

- ✓ TxDOT's Recommended Alignment was based on the data collected during the US 380 Collin County Feasibility Study
- ✓ TxDOT is gathering more data that could change previously studied alignments
- ✓ TxDOT must find an alternative that would best accomplish the project's Purpose and Need and considers the factors in the Alternatives Analysis
- ✓ TxDOT continues to try and develop the least impactful alternative possible for this project, however this is a challenge due to the many constraints
