

PROJECT LIMITS: From SH 78 to Hunt County Line PROJECT LENGTH: Approximately 7.88 miles



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
### Purpose:

The purpose of the proposed project is to meet local and regional future travel demand by increasing capacity of the FM 6; upgrade the transportation infrastructure to meet current FHWA and TxDOT design standards; and improve the safety of the roadway by correcting access conflicts.

### Need:

The proposed improvements are needed because the existing twolane FM 6 roadway between the intersections of SH 78 and Hunt County Line in Collin County is inadequate to meet future traffic volumes, resulting in congestion and reduced mobility, and is a risk to motorist safety because of roadway design deficiencies.


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#### **Proposed Roadway Typical Sections**


