FM 3097 (Horizon Road) Project From Tubbs Road to FM 549 CSJ: 3148-01-013 Rockwall County, Texas



The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and Rockwall County are proposing improvements to Farm-to-Market Road (FM) 3097 (Horizon Road) from Tubbs Road to FM 549 in the cities of Rockwall and Heath, Rockwall County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT and Rockwall County will be conducting an in-person and an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project. **The same information will be available at both the in-person and virtual meetings.**

The in-person public meeting will begin at 6 p.m. and will be an open house format where the public may come and go at their convenience. Staff will be available to answer questions and receive written comments. The virtual meeting can be viewed beginning Thursday, November 16, 2023, starting at 6 p.m. through Friday, December 1, 2023, at 11:59 p.m. The virtual public meeting materials will be posted to the project website at http://www.keepitmovingdallas.com/projects/fm-roads/fm3097 and will consist of a prerecorded video presentation that includes both audio and video components, along with other exhibits. The virtual public meeting is not a live event and the materials can be viewed at your convenience. If you do not have internet access, please call (214) 320-6624 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday to ask questions and access project materials.

The proposed improvements would widen the existing FM 3097 (Horizon Road) from two 11-foot-wide lanes (one in each direction) to four 12-foot-wide lanes (two in each direction) separated by a raised median from Tubbs Road to FM 549, a distance of approximately 1.9 miles, in the cities of Rockwall and Heath, Rockwall County, Texas. An eight to 10-foot-wide shared use path is proposed along both sides of FM 3097 (Horizon Road) within project limits. The existing typical right-of-way (ROW) width varies between approximately 100 to 130 feet. The proposed typical ROW width would vary between approximately 100 to 320 feet. Approximately 8.4 acres of additional ROW would be required.

Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for ROW acquisition and construction can be obtained from the TxDOT ROW office by calling (214) 320-6675.

The proposed project is anticipated to affect a portion of existing trail in the City of Heath that is protected under Section 4(f) of the Department of Transportation Act of 1966. The trail is adjacent to FM 3097 (Horizon Road) from Little Buffalo Creek to FM 549. The proposed project would reconstruct a portion of the trail across the tributary of Little Buffalo Creek to accommodate a proposed culvert extension. No modifications are proposed to the trail from the tributary of Little Buffalo Creek to FM 549. TxDOT anticipates making a *de minimis* determination for this use under Section 4(f) of the Department of Transportation Act of 1966. Public comment on the effects of the proposed project on the activities, features, or attributes of the trail may be submitted as described below.

The proposed project would involve construction in wetlands and an action in a floodplain.

Any environmental documentation or studies, any maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT Dallas District Office, 4777 E. Highway 80, Mesquite, TX 75150-6643. Project materials are also available online at https://www.keepitmovingdallas.com/projects/fm-roads/fm3097. These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person public meeting.

The in-person public meeting and virtual public meeting will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. Las mejoras propuestas ampliarían la FM 3097 (Horizon Road) existente de dos carriles de 11 pies de ancho (uno en cada dirección) a cuatro carriles de 12 pies de ancho (dos en cada dirección) separados por una mediana elevada desde Tubbs Road hasta la FM 549, una distancia de aproximadamente 1.9 millas, en las ciudades de Rockwall y Heath, condado de Rockwall, Texas. Se propone un camino de uso compartido de 8 a 10 pies de ancho a lo largo de la FM 3097 (Horizon Road) con dirección noroeste y sureste dentro de los límites del proyecto. El ancho típico del derecho de vía (o ROW, por sus siglas en inglés) existente varía entre aproximadamente 100 y 130 pies. El ancho típico del derecho de vía propuesto variaría entre aproximadamente 100 y 320 pies. Se necesitarían aproximadamente 8.4 acres de derecho de vía adicionales.

Aunque se requeriría derecho de vía adicional, en este momento no se prevé que ninguna estructura residencial o no residencial sea desplazada. Se puede obtener información sobre los servicios y beneficios disponibles para los propietarios afectados e información sobre el cronograma tentativo para la adquisición del ROW y la construcción en la oficina del ROW de TxDOT llamando al (214) 320-6675.

Se anticipa que el proyecto propuesto afectará una parte del sendero existente en la ciudad de Heath que está protegido bajo la Sección 4(f) de la Ley del Departamento de Transporte de 1966. El sendero está adyacente a la FM 3097 (Horizon Road) desde Little Buffalo Creek hasta la FM 549. El proyecto propuesto reconstruiría una parte del sendero a través del afluente de Little Buffalo Creek para dar cabida a una extensión propuesta de una estructura de drenaje transversal. No se proponen modificaciones al sendero desde el afluente de Little Buffalo Creek hasta la FM 549. TxDOT anticipa tomar una determinación *de minimis* para este uso bajo la Sección 4(f) de la Ley del Departamento de Transporte de 1966. Comentarios públicos sobre los efectos del proyecto propuesto sobre las actividades, características o atributos del sendero puede presentarse como se describe a continuación.

El proyecto propuesto implicaría una construcción en humedales y una acción en una llanura aluvial.







Paxton's long-delayed securities fraud trial set for April

Attorney General Ken Paxton's long-delayed trial on securities fraud charges has been set for April 15.

State District Judge Andrea Beall scheduled the trial during a hearing Monday morning in Houston. Paxton attended the hearing but did not speak at it.

SLIDE 1 - Welcome Slide

Rockwall County and the Texas Department of Transportation, or TxDOT, welcome you to the FM 3097, also known as Horizon Road, Project public meeting. We appreciate your interest in the project and thank each of you for your participation.

Please note, for those viewing the virtual public meeting, you can pause this presentation at any point to allow more time to view the slides or get a more detailed view of the project design or other exhibits available online.

SLIDE 2 - Help End the Streak

November 7, 2000 was the last deathless day on roadways in Texas. That means for over two decades, at least one person has died every single day. We all have a part to play to change that. This message is that reminder – to End the Streak of deaths on Texas highways. We need drivers and passengers to act more responsibly and help us reach our goal of zero deaths by 2050. Texans can play a major role in ending fatal crashes with a few simple driving habits: wear seatbelts, drive the speed limit, put away the phone and other distractions, and never drive under the influence of alcohol or drugs. So, please do your part and share this message with your friends and family.

SLIDE 3 - Public Meeting Purpose

This public meeting has been convened by Rockwall County and TxDOT to receive and consider comments from the public regarding the FM 3097 Project.

You may have attended previous public meetings conducted by TxDOT. However, for the benefit of those who have never attended one, I will explain why and how the Department conducts a public meeting.

A public meeting has four essential purposes:

- 1. To inform the public of the status of planning efforts on the project and to present the recommendations based on studies performed to date.
- 2. To describe the project to the public so the public can determine how they may be affected.

- 3. To provide the public an opportunity to view information and express their ideas and concerns at this stage in the planning process while the ability to respond to comments is still flexible and before location and design decisions are finalized.
- 4. And finally, to develop a record of public views and participation to accompany recommendations for subsequent decisions.

This virtual public meeting is being held in compliance with both federal and state laws. Documentation of this meeting will be made available for the official record.

SLIDE 4 - Project Location

The FM 3097 Project limits are from Tubbs Road to FM 549. The total project length is approximately 1.9 miles and the project is located in the cities of Rockwall and Heath, Rockwall County, Texas. A larger version of this location map is available online and on display on the "Welcome Board" at the in-person public meeting.

SLIDE 5 - Project Purpose and Need

The purpose of the proposed project is to improve mobility and safety by widening FM 3097 (Horizon Road) to a four-lane roadway divided by a raised median.

The proposed project is needed to meet the increasing transportation demands caused by rapid suburban development in surrounding areas. In addition, the proposed project is needed to improve operational efficiency and safety for vehicles traveling on FM 3097.

SLIDE 6 - Existing Typical Section

The existing FM 3097 roadway from Tubbs Road to FM 549 is comprised of two 11-foot-wide lanes, including one southeast bound lane and one northwest bound lane separated by a discontinuous two-way center turn lane, with two-foot-wide shoulders and roadside drainage ditches. An existing shared use path runs adjacent to southwest bound FM 3097 from Little Buffalo Creek to FM 549.

The existing typical right-of-way width varies between approximately 100 to 130 feet.

SLIDE 7 - Proposed Typical Section

Proposed improvements include widening the existing FM 3097 to four 12-foot-wide lanes, two in each direction, separated by a raised median, and curb and gutter drainage improvements. An eight to 10-foot-wide shared use path is proposed along both northwest bound and southeast bound FM 3097 within project limits.

The proposed typical right-of-way width would vary between approximately 100 to 320 feet.

SLIDE 8 - Projected Schedule and Cost

The FM 3097 Project is anticipated to receive environmental clearance in early 2025 and be ready to let in Spring 2028. The total estimated construction cost is \$43 million. The construction phase of the project is currently unfunded and cannot let until funding is identified; however right of way acquisition can proceed even if the project is not funded for construction.

<u>SLIDE 9 - National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Assignment to the Texas Department of Transportation</u>

Prior to December 16, 2014, the Federal Highway Administration, or FHWA, received and approved documents prepared under the National Environmental Policy Act, known as NEPA; however, on December 14, 2014, the Texas Department of Transportation assumed responsibility from FHWA through a Memorandum of Understanding to review and approve certain assigned NEPA environmental documents. This Memorandum of Understanding between TxDOT and FHWA was updated on December 9, 2019. The review and approval process apply to this project. Environmental studies are being conducted for the proposed FM 3097 Project to support an environmental clearance in accordance with NEPA. These environmental analyses are necessary to identify, avoid, and minimize effects to the Human and Natural Environments.

The technical environmental documentation will be approved for further processing by TxDOT and would be coordinated with other public agencies, as necessary. Notices for this public meeting were advertised in English in *The Dallas Morning News*, in English and Spanish in the *Rockwall County Herald-Banner*, on the TxDOT.gov website under "Hearings and Meetings Schedule" and on www.keepitmovingdallas.com under "Public Hearings and Meetings."

SLIDE 10 - Environmental Constraints Map

The project Environmental Constraints Map is used to help planners and engineers at the outset of a roadway project to increase awareness of environmental constraints and to help minimize potential project impacts while meeting the project purpose. The full-size constraints map is available as a display at the in-person public meeting or it can be viewed online through the virtual public meeting page. The major known constraints include stream crossings, associated floodplain, and an existing trail adjacent to FM 3097 in the City of Heath that is protected under Section 4(f) of the Department of Transportation Act of 1966. Environmental studies for this project are ongoing.

SLIDE 11 - Right-of-Way

Approximately 8.4 acres of new right-of-way are anticipated for the proposed project. No displacements are anticipated. All right-of-way acquisition would be completed in accordance with the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, as amended. The brochure titled "The Purchase of Right of Way," is available on the project website. 


Existing and Proposed Typical Sections


Existing ROW Varies 100 – 130 feet

Proposed Typical Section



The Section 4(f) Process



Section 4(f) is a federal regulation set up to protect the use of public land in projects.

Section 4(f) of the U.S. Department of Transportation Act of 1966 stipulates that TxDOT cannot approve the use of land from:

- Publicly owned parks or recreational areas
- Wildlife and waterfowl refuges
- Public and private historic sites


Unless the following conditions apply:

- There is no feasible and prudent avoidance alternative to the use of that land; and the action includes all possible planning to minimize harm to the property resulting from use; OR
- TxDOT determines that the use of the property will have a de minimis, minimal impact.

City of Heath Trail System

The proposed project is anticipated to affect a portion of existing trail in the City of Heath. The trail is adjacent to FM 3097 (Horizon Road) from Little Buffalo Creek to FM 549.

- The proposed project would reconstruct a portion of the trail across the tributary of Little Buffalo Creek to accommodate a proposed culvert extension.
- The use of this land is considered minimal and TxDOT anticipates making a Section 4(f) de minimis determination for this use.



This federal regulation requires TxDOT to inform and gather input from the public. The public is encouraged to be involved with the Section 4(f) process by asking questions and expressing concerns about historic properties and public and recreation areas.


