
# HIRING STATS FOR WORKERS

- 77% percent of firms


“...candidates lack the skills needed to work in construction or cannot pass a drug test.”

- 1B in construction spending = 3,900 new jobs.

# HIRING STATS FOR WORKERS

- Nationally, pipe-layers, sheet metal workers, carpenters, concrete workers, and pipefitters/welders are particularly hard to find in terms of hourly wage jobs.
  - The five toughest-to-fill salaried jobs are project managers/supervisors, engineers, estimating personnel, quality control personnel, and technical designers.
- 

# HIRING STATS FOR WORKERS

- Technology ... helping firms cope with labor shortages.
  - 87% percent of firms agree that their employees need to possess digital technology skills to be successful as firms adopt new technologies.
  - And while few candidates possess key construction skills, nearly two-thirds of responding firms say at least half of the people they are hiring possess the technology skills they need.

# FHWA

- **Federal Highway Administration**
  - Part of the Department of Transportation.
  - Is a cabinet level organization of the Executive Branch.
  - Provides financial support for state and local government projects.
  - Does research in safety, construction materials and methods.
  - Receives funding from fuel and motor vehicle excise taxes.
  - Provides grant funding for training programs like this one.
  - Davis-Bacon Act of 1931 – Prevailing Wages


# TXDOT

- Texas Department of Transportation
  - State government - answerable to the State Congressional Transportation Committee
  - Headquartered in Austin, dividing the state into 25 Districts
  - Receives money from FHWA
  - Designs and oversees most projects
  - Monthly Letting
  - Civil Rights Division – administers programs like the TCCA (OJT/SS), OJT, and DBE programs.

# CIVIL RIGHTS DIVISION (CIV)

- Mission: Promote diversity and inclusion on TxDOT projects.
- Monitor contract goals.
- Manage and support opportunities for training – including for Pre-Employment Training (TCCA).

# AGC

- Association of General Contractors
    - Private Contractors
    - Headquartered in Austin
    - Publishes the Orange Book
    - Encourages training programs to meet participation goals
-

- Texas Construction Career Academy
  - Started in 2009. Travels around the state.

  - Hosts job fairs.

    3. Endure the review process (6-12 months).

# TIPS

- Make sure your contact info is valid and stays the same for the whole review period.
- Read & Respond to emails completely and correctly.
- Be prepared to share all of your financial statements – banking, tax documents, etc.
- Have quality references to provide feedback about your subject of expertise.
- Don't over-promise and under-deliver!!!
