Steps to Successful Teaming

- **Become TxDOT Pre-Certified (unless exempt - NLC)**
- **Check current status (yearly renewal through CCIS)**
- **Have status re-evaluated when changes occur**
- **Become Administratively Qualified (unless exempt)**
- **Develop Marketing Material**
- **Be familiar with TxDOT Projects and Procedures**

Steps to Successful Teaming (cont'd.)

- Meet and become familiar with the firm(s) you intend to team with
- Meet and become familiar with TxDOT District Engineers
- Join local Engineering Societies and/or Organizations
- Establish a “Reputation of Excellence”
- Be “Aggressive” in pursuing work
