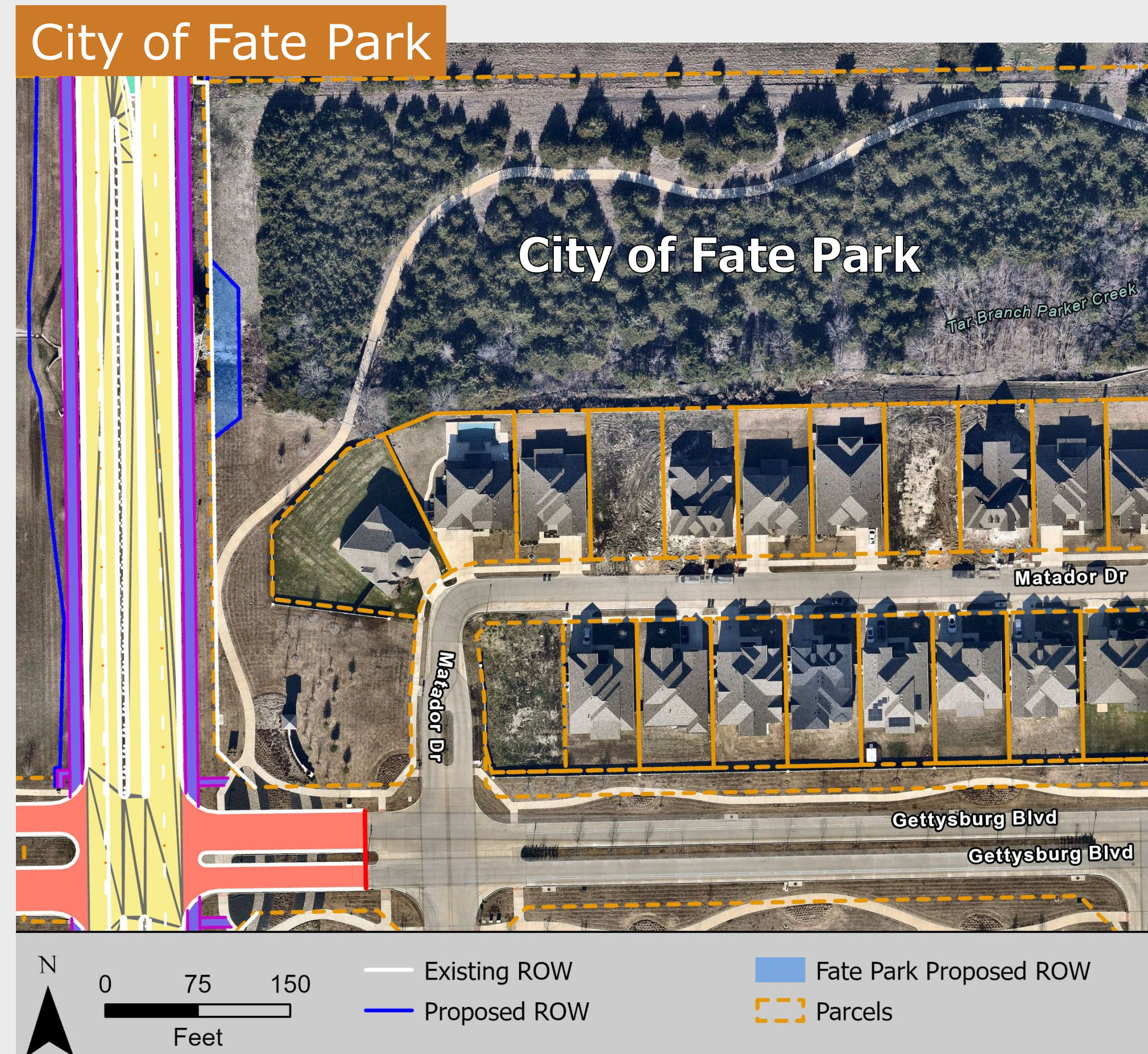


Section 4(f), Section 106 & Chapter 26

Connecting you with Texas.

Section 4(f) of the U.S. Department of Transportation Act of 1966 and Chapter 26 of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Code are federal and state regulations, respectively, set up to protect the use of public lands. These regulations require TxDOT to inform and gather input from the public.



Protected Properties

- City of Fate Park
 - Located between Charleston Lane and Gettysburg Boulevard along FM 551 in Fate, Texas
 - Protected by Section 4(f) and Chapter 26
- Fate Presbyterian Church
 - National Register of Historic Places
 - Located at 202 William E Crawford Avenue in Fate, Texas.
 - Protected by Section 4(f) and Section 106

The proposed project would require minimal right of way and would not result in adverse effects to either of these properties
