Project Purpose:


Improve safety, increase mobility, and meet current design standards.

Project Need:

The proposed project is needed because the capacity of FM 551 is inadequate to meet current and future traffic volumes, resulting in congestion and reduced mobility.

Existing Typical Section






- Two 11-foot-wide travel lanes
- No shoulders in each direction
- 80-foot existing right of way
- No bicycle or pedestrian facilities

Proposed Typical Section






- Four 12-foot-wide travel lanes (2 lanes in each direction)
- Two-foot-wide curbed inside and outside shoulders (in each direction)
- Two 10-foot-wide shared-use path (1 in each direction)
- 18-foot grassy median
- 140 to 235-foot proposed right of way

Proposed Typical Section





Two 12-foot-wide travel lanes (1 lane in each direction)

Path

Two-foot-wide curbed shoulders (in each direction)

Turn Lane

One 14-foot center turn lane

Path

- Two 10-foot wide shared-use path (1 in each direction)
- 90 to 200-foot proposed right of way

 Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970
