The National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) requires federal agencies to assess the environmental effects of their proposed actions prior to making decisions

An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is prepared when it is anticipated that a proposed project could significantly affect the quality of the human and natural environment

This phase of the project is a more in-depth and focused study using the information from the Feasibility Study

Adhering to NEPA is required on any project that would receive any federal funding
