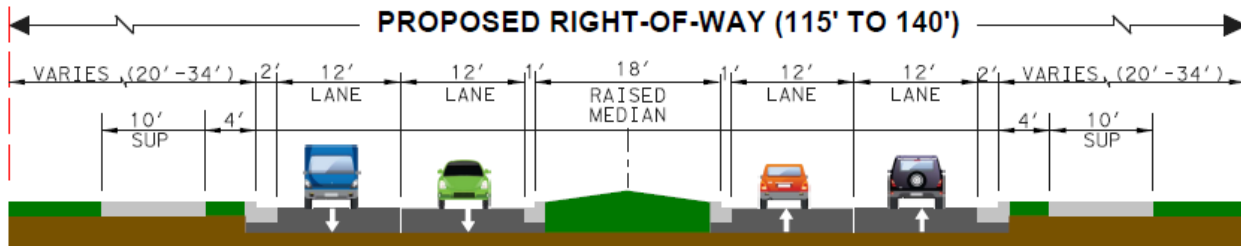
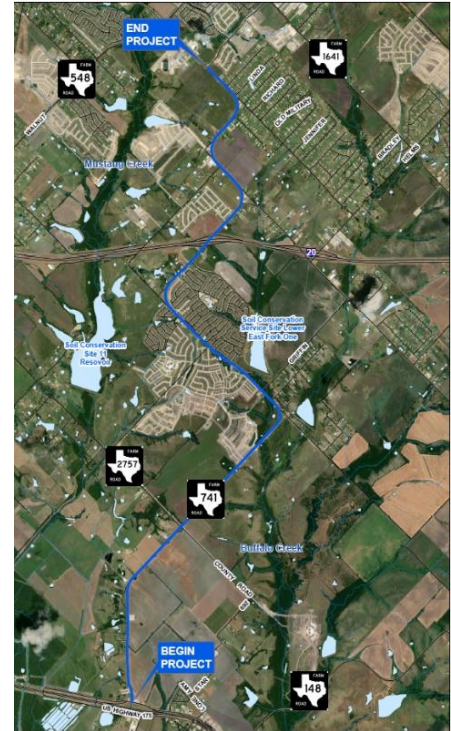
FM 741 WIDENING

Project Details

The Texas Department of Transportation Dallas District is proposing to reconstruct and widen FM 741 from US 175 to south of FM 548 in Kaufman county. The project is needed to meet future traffic demands, to meet current design standards and to address safety. Additionally, it is needed to provide continuous pedestrian and bike accommodations on both sides along the corridor.

The Proposed 7.72 Miles Project Includes:

- Reconstructing and widening the existing undivided two lanes rural roadway to a proposed divided four lanes urban roadway with 12-foot lanes, 18-foot wide median and ultimate 6-lanes from US 175 to FM 2757
- Providing left and right turn bays in certain locations
- Replacing the two existing bridges over Tributary to Buffalo Creek with a wider and longer bridge to accommodate four 12-foot wide travel lanes and 10-foot wide pedestrian/bike Shared Use Path (SUP) on both sides
- Widen the Right-Of-Way (ROW) width from existing 70' to 100' wide to a proposed 140' wide from US 175 to FM 2757 and to 115'-130' from FM 2757 to end of project
