Project Purpose and Need

Project Purpose:

The purpose of the proposed project is to improve mobility and safety by providing a facility that meets current design and safety standards.


Project Need:

The proposed project is needed because FM 2755 from SH 78 to CR 541:

- **a)** is within an area that is experiencing growth with an anticipated future increase in traffic demand resulting in reduced mobility along FM 2755; and
- **b)** does not meet current design and safety standards for travel lane widths, shoulders, and geometry.




Existing Facility



- Mainly consists of two undivided 11-foot-wide rural lanes with 2-foot-wide shoulders.
- Side and cross streets within the project limits include Lake Road and CR 483.
- There is currently no center median, sidewalks, or shared-use paths along the corridor.


Interim Proposed Facility



- Four-lane roadway with a center raised median.
- Proposed 12-foot-wide travel lanes with 2-foot offset, and 10-foot-wide shared-use paths on each side.
- The proposed ROW width varies from 120 to 211 feet.



Proposed Facility



- Six-lane roadway with a center raised median.
- Proposed 12-foot-wide travel lanes with 2-foot offset, and 10-foot-wide shared-use paths on each side.
- The proposed ROW width varies from 120 to 211 feet.

^{*} The project is not yet funded and cannot be let until funding is identified; however, right-of-way acquisition can proceed even if the project is not funded for construction.





Proposed Right of Way

The project would require approximately 14.8 acres of additional right of way.

One potential displacement may be required.
