


LOOP 12 PROJECT LIMITS:

From Spur 408 to south of SH 183 within the cities of Dallas and Irving in Dallas County

PROJECT LENGTH:

Approximately 10 miles



Project Purpose & Need






Loop 12 is a major highway serving the Dallas Metropolitan Area that is located within an area that is experiencing rapid growth. Loop 12 is anticipated to continue providing improved north-south mobility and connectivity in the future. The project is needed because Loop 12 between Spur 408 and south of SH 183: a) does not meet current and future traffic volumes, resulting in congestion and reduced mobility, and b) does not meet minimum design standards for travel lane widths, horizontal and vertical geometry.

The purpose of the proposed project is to construct a facility following current roadway design standards that improves mobility and meets anticipated traffic demand.


Existing Roadway Typical Section



Existing between Spur 408 and SH 356




Existing between SH 356 and SH 183




Proposed Roadway Typical Section




Six general purpose main lanes proposed between Davis St. and Shady Grove Rd.



Eight general purpose main lanes proposed between Spur 408 and Davis St. and between Shady Grove Rd. to south of SH 183



Proposed Roadway Typical Section (cont.)



- Shared-use path for bicyclists and pedestrians along the northbound frontage road
- Sidewalk improvements along the southbound frontage road
- Other pedestrian and bicycle improvements include sidewalks and bicycle paths at street crossings


