

Project Details

This public meeting will discuss TxDOT's proposed improvements to US 80 & Spur 557 that include:

- Reconstructing US 80 & Spur 557 from a four-lane divided to a sixlane divided highway.
- Reconstructing two to three lane, one way frontage roads.
- Ramping and intersection improvements.
- Construction of shared use path and sidewalks.

Project Purpose and Need



The proposed project's purpose is to improve safety and mobility to accommodate for future traffic volumes.


Project Need:

Existing and Proposed Typical Sections – US 80








PROPOSED US 80

Proposed Right-of-Way (ROW)

- Approximately 56 acres of new ROW would be required.
- Potential displacements include two residences, one business, and two non-residential structures (billboards).
- All ROW acquisition would be completed in accordance with the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, as amended.



Estimated Total Project Cost* Approximately \$850 million


