Environmental Review





- Portions of the project corridor are situated within FEMA designated 100-year flood hazard areas.
- These flood hazard areas are associated with Elm Creek, Cowskin Creek and Brushy Creek.
- The hydraulic design for this project would be in accordance with current TxDOT policies.



Waters of the U.S.

- This project would involve construction in one wetland within the project area. The wetland is located approximately 130 feet west of the proposed at-grade intersection at CR 697.
- The proposed project would implement all necessary best management practices and take necessary measures to minimize impacts to waters of the U.S.



Traffic Noise

• Based on the traffic noise analysis, the proposed project would result in traffic noise impacts with no feasible and reasonable abatement. Therefore, no traffic noise mitigation is proposed for incorporation into the project.



Historic

- Two properties were determined eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places: Caddo Park and the Farmersville Riding Club.
- The proposed project would not require additional ROW and has no potential of adverse effects on these properties.
