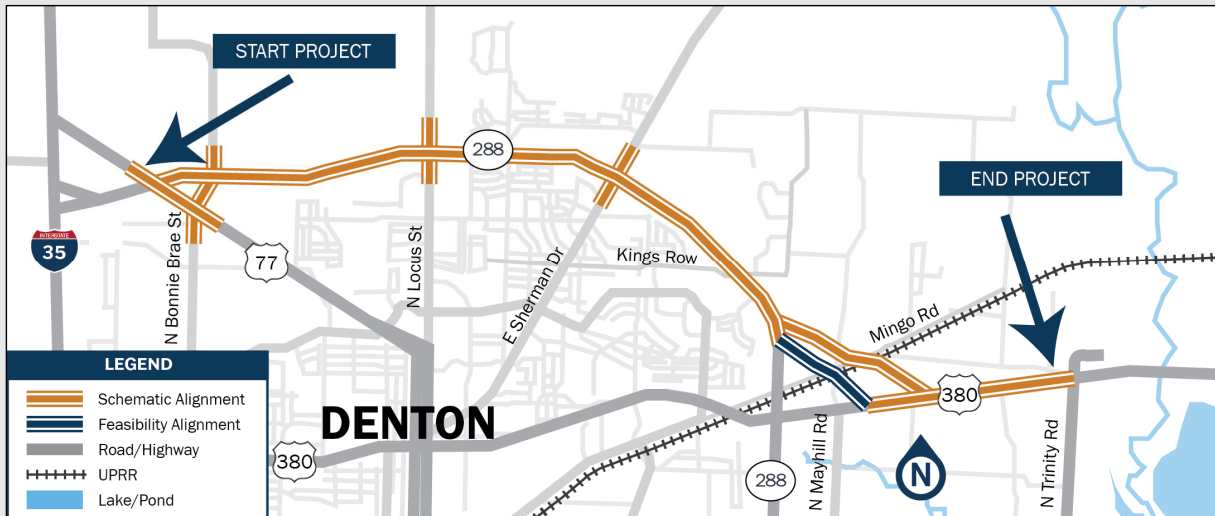
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Project Location Map

Project Purpose:

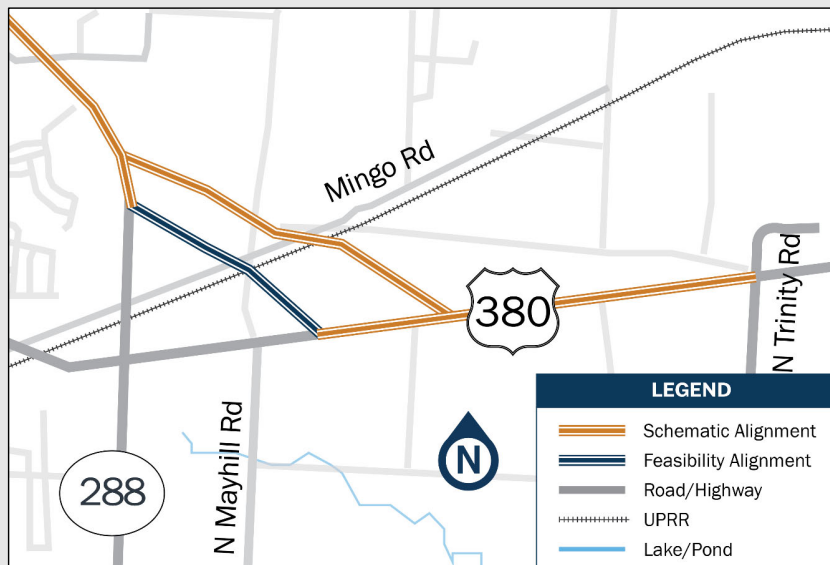
Improve safety, increase mobility and meet current design standards.

The proposed project is needed to meet future travel demands stemming from projected population growth and traffic volumes.

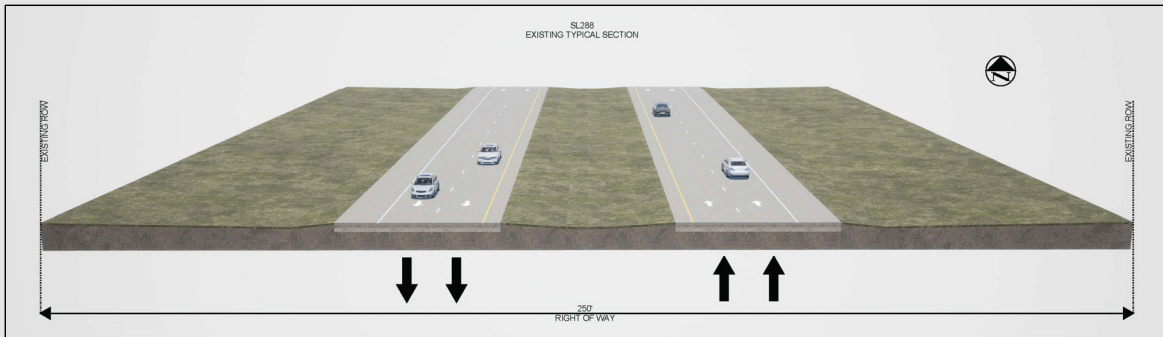
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Project History Map



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Existing Typical Section – SL 288



- Consists of two 12-foot-wide travel lanes in each direction with 4-foot inside shoulders and 10-foot outside shoulders
- Existing right of way is a minimum of 250-foot-wide
- No existing sidewalk, bicycle or pedestrian facilities

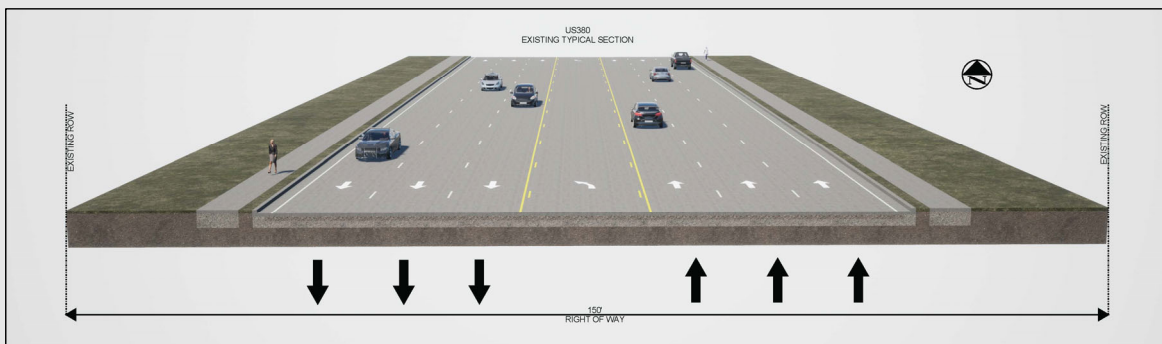
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Existing Typical Section – US 380



- Consists of three 12-foot-wide travel lanes in each direction with a two-way left-turn lane
- Existing right of way is 150-foot-wide
- Partial existing sidewalk, bicycle and pedestrian facilities

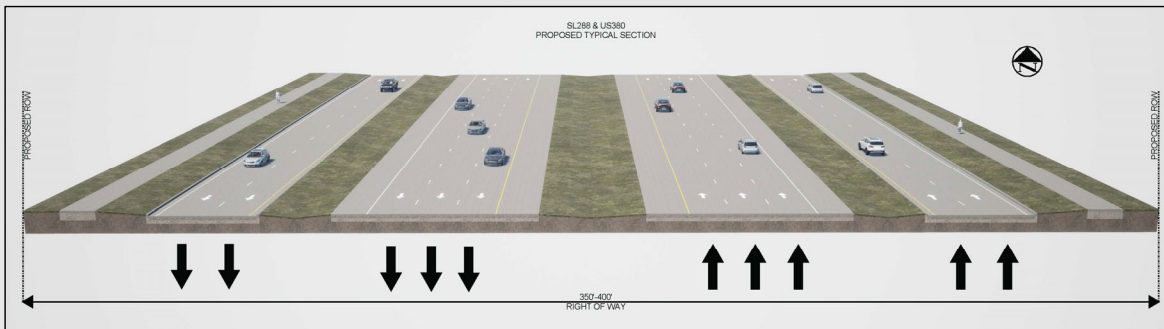
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Proposed Typical Section (SL 288 and US 380)



SL 288 Project Improvements:

- Widen to six-lane freeway section
- Construct two-lane frontage road in both directions
- Addition of a 10-foot shared-use path on both sides
- Interchange improvements at US 77, Bonnie Brae Street, Locust Street, and Sherman Drive
- Proposed right of way ranges from 350- to 400-feet

**Project is currently unfunded for construction and cannot let until funding is identified; however, right-of-way acquisition can proceed even if the project is not funded for construction.*

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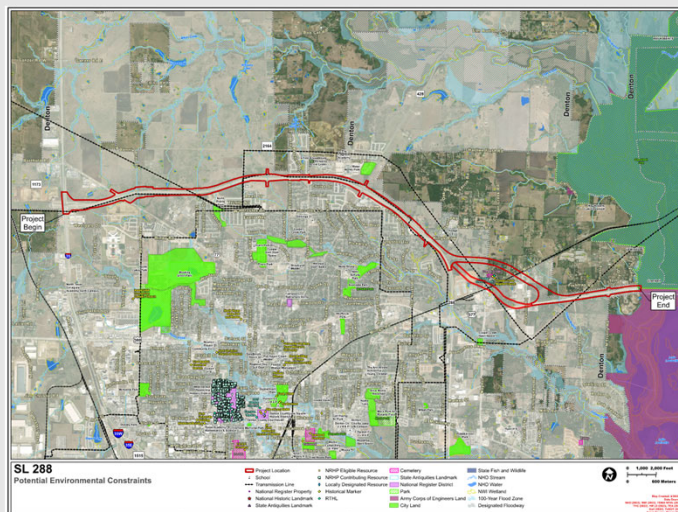

Proposed Right of Way & Displacements

Schematic Alignment

- Approximately 190 new acres of right of way
- Potentially 26 residential, 5 commercial and 22 outbuilding displacements

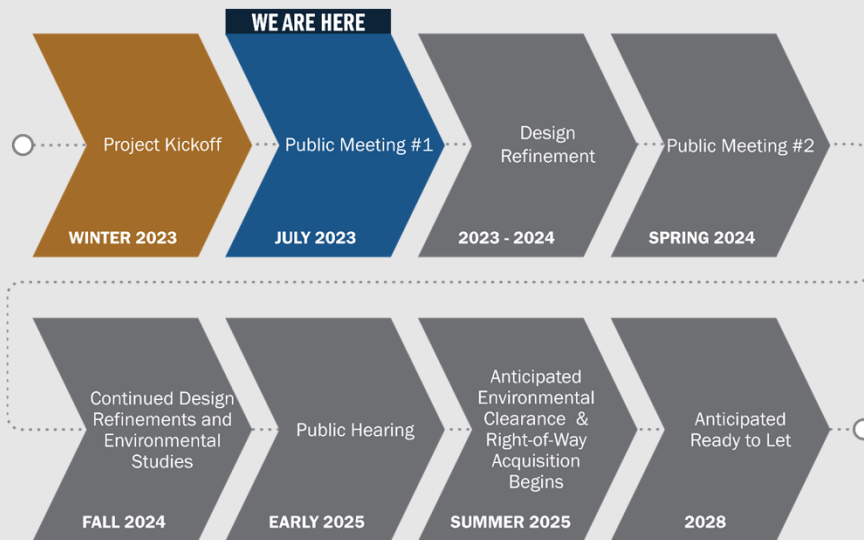
Feasibility Study Alignment

- Approximately 139 new acres of right of way
- Potentially 9 residential, 2 commercial and 1 outbuilding displacements

- Right-of-way acquisition will be in accordance with the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970
