Project Purpose:


Improve safety, increase mobility and meet current design standards.

The proposed project is needed to meet future travel demands stemming from projected population growth and traffic volumes.


Adjacent Projects Map






Existing Typical Section





- Consists of two 12-foot-wide travel lanes in each direction with 4-foot inside shoulders and 10-foot outside shoulders
- Existing right of way ranges from 300- to 400-feet-wide
- No existing sidewalk, bicycle or pedestrian facilities

Proposed Typical Section




- Construction of two new 12-foot-wide frontage roads in each direction with variable left-hand turn lanes both northbound and southbound
- Addition of a 10-foot shared-use path on the north side and a 6-foot sidewalk on the south side of the frontage roads of US 287
- Interchange improvements
- Proposed right of way ranges from 300- to 500-feet

Estimated Construction Cost* **\$310M**

*Project is currently unfunded for construction and cannot let until funding is identified; however, right-of-way acquisition can proceed even if the project is not funded for construction.



Right of Way




- Proposed Right of Way & Displacements
 - Acquisition of approximately 22.2 acres of right of way would be required for the proposed project
 - One non-residential displacement is anticipated as a result of the proposed project
 - Right-of-way acquisition will be in accordance with the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970
